

Sermon Title: **“THERE’S HOPE ... IN CHRIST”**

Luke 24:1-12

- \_\_\_\_\_ is the culmination and climax to what ALL of the Old Testament \_\_\_\_\_ and longed for (without Easter the Old Testament is incomplete)
- These ladies left in a \_\_\_\_\_ (they were mourning Jesus’ death and they were going to say their final goodbyes)
- The \_\_\_\_\_, which covered Jesus’ tomb had been \_\_\_\_\_
  - The stone was rolled away to let the \_\_\_\_\_ IN (these \_\_\_\_\_ needed to enter the tomb and see the truth)
- “Perplexed” = they were filled with \_\_\_\_\_
