## Sermon Title: **“HEALING THE TEN LEPERS”**

Luke 17:11-19

- The book of Leviticus uses the word “\_\_\_\_\_” about \_\_\_\_\_
- These \_\_\_\_\_ see Jesus approaching and they seized the opportunity – they ask Jesus to have \_\_\_\_\_ on them
- Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ them clean and the priests were going to \_\_\_\_\_ that cleaning and the 10 lepers would be \_\_\_\_\_ to clean
- \_\_\_\_\_ were tainted by intermarrying with \_\_\_\_\_, they ALSO ONLY used the Pentateuch
  - They believed the primary place of worship was to be a \_\_\_\_\_
- ANYONE with this \_\_\_\_\_ were to live at a distance (on the outskirts of towns) away from family and friends
  - Leprosy ALSO effected the \_\_\_\_\_ – so this declaration would have been VERY \_\_\_\_\_
- Priests had separated miracles into TWO categories (\_\_\_\_\_ miracles and \_\_\_\_\_ miracles) – Leprosy was a messianic miracle
- These lepers were \_\_\_\_\_ (they KNEW they had a \_\_\_\_\_) and when they saw Jesus coming they \_\_\_\_\_ to Him for help
- These lepers left Jesus solely on the promise to \_\_\_\_\_ themselves to the priests (and their \_\_\_\_\_ was rewarded)
- “They were cleansed” = to be pure; to be without stain or spot; to have ALL filth or impurity \_\_\_\_\_
- This Samaritan comes back to Jesus – clearly wanting more than \_\_\_\_\_, this guy wanted the \_\_\_\_\_
- The ONLY ONE to return to Jesus, giving Him \_\_\_\_\_ is this foreigner (this person, who was not Jewish)
