	established a false religion	
•	God is NOT impressed or interested in our	attempts to
	approach Him in worship (there's one way)
•	"Hear" = diligently listen;	; give
	heed (hear with the intent to obey)	
•	This speaks to (being in agreement	and on the same page)
•	Hearing this alarm meant there was a	approaching –
	inhabitants of that city would	
•	What God reveals, God expects an	response (Action
	MUST follow instruction)	
•	was a prominent Philistine city and along with	
	– both oppressed Israel	
	o Those wicked and carnal cities were to act as to the	
	horrific violence and devastation that was on the horizon	
•	God was going to use one of His	(which were close by) to
	His own children (Israel)	
•	"Altars of Bethel" = refers to the	practice of worshiping
	the golden calf (which resided inside their	temple)
	o God was condemning Israel's	_, self-reliance, and
	exploitation of and	against the vulnerable
