Luke 23:39-43

- \_\_\_\_\_ – DIDN'T stay silent, he rebukes the 1<sup>st</sup> robber
- “\_\_\_\_\_” = written in imperfect tense, which means this was an act done over and over and over again
- This thief's \_\_\_\_\_ led him to \_\_\_\_\_
- Even unlearned and non-Jewish people were able to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus was special and \_\_\_\_\_
- This thief \_\_\_\_\_ by the weight of his personal guilt, STOPS making excuses and \_\_\_\_\_ the Supreme Authority of Jesus
