

Sermon Title: **“THE HEARTS HAVE EYES”**

Ephesians 1:15-23

- Join Paul in this prayer – may we know our God better
 - “Know” = to know deeply; to know personally; to know intimately
- From this prayer, Paul asks for 4 eye-opening, monumental, soul-stirring realities to impact these Ephesian Believers
 1. That the Eyes of our Heart may be Enlightened
 2. That we Know the Hope of His Calling
 3. That we Know what are the Riches of the Glory of His Inheritance in the Saints
 4. That we Know what is the Boundless Greatness of His Power
- These Ephesians’ faith was evident & so was their love
- What regular & routine steps are you intentionally making to develop & cultivate that growth in your life?
- Is that the SAME mentality that we’re pursuing to know God better?
- The heart – that’s the location to where your treasure is stored
 - What that means is what we value (what our focus is on) that’s where we will spend our time (that’s what we’ll pursue)
- If we’re Spiritually Blinded, what we read in Scripture WON’T make ANY sense, it’ll appear ALL blurry at best
- We NEED to have ALL the information, we have in our heads, to come out ALIVE in our hearts
