

Sermon Title: **“SERVE ... ONE ANOTHER”**

Galatians 5:13-15

- The Book of Galatians is ALL about \_\_\_\_\_
  - Chapters 1-2 = A call to return and stand upon God’s \_\_\_\_\_
  - Chapters 3-4 = The glories of God’s \_\_\_\_\_ explained
  - Chapters 5-6 = Daily living, which stems from God’s \_\_\_\_\_
- Part of the point to the Law was that ALL of us \_\_\_\_\_ of perfection (that we ALL desperately NEED help)
- There is \_\_\_\_\_ that \_\_\_\_\_ to our salvation (Christ’s substitutionary sacrificial death on the cross is sufficient)
  - Our relationship with Jesus is entered into \_\_\_\_\_ and it is secured and cemented by God’s abundant grace
- Believers are to \_\_\_\_\_ upon God’s grace because there are distractions and deceptive counterfeits that seek to deter us
- “\_\_\_\_\_” = to invite by way of attracting attention and drawing someone near
  - The emphasis of our salvation is \_\_\_\_\_ on God’s grace
- Selflessly we ought to \_\_\_\_\_ one another
- God’s design is the last is first and the first is last (the \_\_\_\_\_ are exalted and the prideful humbled)
