

Sermon Title: **“RICH IN GOOD WORKS”**

I Timothy 6:17-21

- Money by itself is NOT \_\_\_\_\_. It's the \_\_\_\_\_ of it that's \_\_\_\_\_.
- In contrast, Paul instructs Timothy to tell those believers with money to NOT be \_\_\_\_\_ & fix their \_\_\_\_\_ on God ALONE
  - When you make it about what you've \_\_\_\_\_ (or amassed) you've \_\_\_\_\_ the WHO that's truly behind everything
  - Paul's telling Timothy to focus on the \_\_\_\_\_ NOT the \_\_\_\_\_ (encourage those with wealth – which is fine to have – to do the same)
- What are you doing with what God's \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_?
  - Do good & be rich in \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ (invest in things with merit)
- Why was the \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ of 2 mites so impressive? (Mark 12:41-44)
  - Giving to God ISN'T about a \_\_\_\_\_ it's from an overflowing heart filled with \_\_\_\_\_ it acknowledges it ALL came from \_\_\_\_\_
  - Imagine if EVERY believer in this church \_\_\_\_\_ their \_\_\_\_\_ (used their gifts & their talents – cheerfully & in abundance)
  - Let God use you ... Let God use what He's \_\_\_\_\_ to you ... without \_\_\_\_\_ & without \_\_\_\_\_ (cheerfully & in abundance)
- Paul wraps up this letter with one more appeal to Timothy to stay \_\_\_\_\_ in the Truth (God's Word) & \_\_\_\_\_ against strange teaching
  - For whatever reason, if we're NOT careful, we can take our eyes off of \_\_\_\_\_ & forget about the \_\_\_\_\_ ALL around us
