

Sermon Title: **“I AM NOT ASHAMED”**

II Timothy 1:8-14

- We DON'T have to be \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_
- With everything that had happened recently: Paul in \_\_\_\_\_ & great widespread \_\_\_\_\_ throughout ALL of the Roman Empire
  - Some had \_\_\_\_\_ ship – they had \_\_\_\_\_ from the faith
- “Ashamed” = to feel shame or \_\_\_\_\_ for something
  - With Paul being put in \_\_\_\_\_ some people had used that as a reason to \_\_\_\_\_ their relationship with Christ
  - When you go through a period of \_\_\_\_\_ or a time of trouble the \_\_\_\_\_ that you \_\_\_\_\_ with God is unparalleled
- When we think about Who Jesus is & what He's done we should \_\_\_\_\_ & stand in \_\_\_\_\_ (drawing us to utter worship)!
- ALL of the Bible (Old Testament included) points to God's \_\_\_\_\_
  - What Jesus did on the \_\_\_\_\_ we could NEVER have done
  - This message of Hope is \_\_\_\_\_ to EACH of us to \_\_\_\_\_
  - Make it personal – If our \_\_\_\_\_ was rocked how \_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus would we still be? (Are we really ALL-in for Jesus?)
- \_\_\_\_\_ on Who God is helps to keep our minds \_\_\_\_\_ in the reality of what God's truly \_\_\_\_\_ of doing on our behalf
- When Paul accepted Christ as his personal Savior, Paul committed his entire life into Jesus' hands (Paul \_\_\_\_\_ himself to God)
  - Remember & dwell on the \_\_\_\_\_ you have in Jesus Christ & the \_\_\_\_\_ that you've experienced firsthand
