II Timothy 2:8-13

- The Bible talks in many locations about the importance of \_\_\_\_\_:
  - Deuteronomy 5:15
  - I Corinthians 11:23-26
  - Joshua 4:1-7
- Remember \_\_\_\_\_ (Dwell upon Who He is)
- Remember the \_\_\_\_\_ that Paul was currently sitting in \_\_\_\_\_
  - Paul \_\_\_\_\_ God & \_\_\_\_\_ on Jesus in the midst of hardship
- Listen to the four \_\_\_\_\_ statements that Paul makes:
