- Judah could NOT drive out the inhabitants of the valley because they had _____
 - “This spoke more to Judah’s lack of full trust in God than it did to Canaanite military superiority. Chariots were NO problem for God’s people when they were trusting God. Their attitude should have been like that reflected in Psalm 20:7 – ‘Some boast in chariots, & some in horses; but we will boast in the name of the Lord our God.’”
- Once in Hebron, Caleb had to drive out (& he did) the _____ sons of Anak, who were _____ men & fierce _____
 - Caleb was an _____ man, yet in God’s strength he defeated these 3 mighty giants. Compare that to the _____ of _____ Judah displayed
- “The house of Joseph” = refers to the combined tribes of _____ & _____ (cf. Joshua 17:17)
- The location of _____ is interesting. It apparently sat on the _____ of the territory given to Ephraim & the territory given to Benjamin
 - We again DON’T see them _____ ALL of the inhabitants, a nameless man is allowed to stay (& he built the city of Luz)

 - Each tribe is connected to _____ to completely drive out the Canaanites (which was God’s clear command)
