Sermon Title: **"HIS LOVINGKINDNESS IS EVERLASTING (PART I)"** Psalm 136:1-9

- The least we can do is be thankful to God
 - God by His very nature is ALL good
 - Once you've gotten a firsthand experience to God's goodness it creates an insatiable hunger for MORE
- 26 times the phrase "for His lovingkindness is everlasting" is repeated this is the most repeated phrase in ANY chapter in ALL the Bible
 - That phrase should overwhelm us & should get stuck in our heads
- ALL authority stems from God (He's the creator & sustainer of ALL things)
 - People ALL over the world worship their "idols" with incredible passion, how much more should we passionately praise & be thankful to the One & only God of ALL gods?
- Our thankfulness should be overflowing & should be something that we readily communicate & share with others
- Everything God does is wonderful
 - Anything positive that man does is simply God using man as an instrument (It's ALL God doing wonders)
- God spoke & everything was created with order & purpose
 - God knows our greatest need & with the same type of precision God sent His Son, Jesus, with a purpose to rescue us
- Each & every act of creation pushes us (the created) to praise God & acknowledge our gratitude to Him
 - We are recipients of God's goodness for NO other reason than God delights in us
