

Sermon Title: **“LORD, LORD”**

Matthew 7:21-23

- Jesus concludes this passage of Scripture with a very \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ truth (which makes everything very \_\_\_\_\_)
- There are some people who will live their lives \_\_\_\_\_ they are in a right relationship with Almighty God but in reality they \_\_\_\_\_ really knew God \_\_\_\_\_
  - Jesus is teaching this for a \_\_\_\_\_ and we CAN'T gloss over it or brush it off and disregard its \_\_\_\_\_
- Simultaneously by our words we ‘ \_\_\_\_\_ ’ = we agree with God and we ‘ \_\_\_\_\_ ’ = we turn from our sin and go the opposite direction
  - This relationship is \_\_\_\_\_ through our daily surrendering
- It comes down to will we \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus and will we \_\_\_\_\_ Him?
- When we are living in \_\_\_\_\_ disobedience to the Lord then we are revealing that our \_\_\_\_\_ DON'T know God
  - Living this way should cause us to \_\_\_\_\_
  - What we're talking about is NOT \_\_\_\_\_. This is blatant and \_\_\_\_\_ of God and His standards
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ – 3 times claiming to do things in the name of the Lord – reveals how \_\_\_\_\_ they had become
- There is NO \_\_\_\_\_ and NO \_\_\_\_\_ that any of us can give that is acceptable (God sees us for \_\_\_\_\_ who we are)
- It's NOT enough to simply \_\_\_\_\_ I'm a follower of Christ, our \_\_\_\_\_ MUST prove that (there MUST be \_\_\_\_\_)
