

Sermon Title: **“STRANGERS & FOREIGNERS: UNASHAMED FAITH”**

Hebrews 11:13-16

- In general, we’re so preoccupied comparing ourselves \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ that we miss comparing ourselves \_\_\_\_\_
  - Our relationship with Christ has made us \_\_\_\_\_.  
Therefore, we should live like it and stop \_\_\_\_\_  
the world
- Specifically addresses the \_\_\_\_\_ (Father Abraham and Sarah;  
Isaac; and Jacob)
- Faith is unashamedly \_\_\_\_\_ when the rest of the  
world is in rejection (it’s knowing we \_\_\_\_\_ here)
- “In Faith” = is literally translated “\_\_\_\_\_” (the  
dominating common denominator in these individuals’ lives was their faith  
– it \_\_\_\_\_ how they lived)
- God promised \_\_\_\_\_ and that promise was passed to  
\_\_\_\_\_ and from Isaac it was passed to \_\_\_\_\_
- NOT ONLY did they live by faith, they “\_\_\_\_\_”  
(they lived by faith up until their very last breath) – their \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ was wrapped in faith
- Believers in 2023 have a clearer \_\_\_\_\_ of God and how  
He has \_\_\_\_\_ and what He’s \_\_\_\_\_
- Faith sees the \_\_\_\_\_ and faith trusts in the \_\_\_\_\_
- Those who are strangers and exiles on earth, \_\_\_\_\_  
communicate through their lives that this world is \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_
  - 1 – We will never fully be \_\_\_\_\_ in this world
  - 2 – We publicly \_\_\_\_\_ in God
  - 3 – We \_\_\_\_\_ stop looking ahead \_\_\_\_\_
- God attaches Himself to those who \_\_\_\_\_ cling to Him
