

Sermon Title: **“MOSES: CHRIST-CENTERED FAITH”**

Hebrews 11:23-28

- Moses \_\_\_\_\_ God and \_\_\_\_\_ upon God to provide and protect \_\_\_\_\_ along the way
- Faith is \_\_\_\_\_ Christ (it’s treasuring Christ more than all the \_\_\_\_\_ of the world)
- Amram and Jochebed might be pretty \_\_\_\_\_ OT figures, but to God their faith is held in \_\_\_\_\_
  - Both Amram and Jochebed \_\_\_\_\_ and together they concealed baby \_\_\_\_\_ for 3 months
  - Couples need to commit to crafting a \_\_\_\_\_ in childrearing (they need to come together in a \_\_\_\_\_ front)
- Moses is pulled out of the \_\_\_\_\_ and raised in the \_\_\_\_\_ of the most affluent \_\_\_\_\_ of that time

- The Parallels to \_\_\_\_\_ are Striking:

  - 3. BOTH left royalty to \_\_\_\_\_
  - 4. BOTH serve as \_\_\_\_\_ (a bridge between God and man)
  - 5. BOTH were \_\_\_\_\_ by the people they came to deliver
  - Moses \_\_\_\_\_ the Messiah in a multitude of ways
- “Refused” = to say no; to \_\_\_\_\_; to \_\_\_\_\_
- Where did Moses focus his \_\_\_\_\_?
  - It was on \_\_\_\_\_ (Moses clung to God’s \_\_\_\_\_ of a Messiah), Moses lived in that reality although \_\_\_\_\_ had not yet come
- The parallel picture is pretty plain: Continue to stubbornly \_\_\_\_\_ and lose everything OR embrace \_\_\_\_\_ of salvation and be passed over
