

Sermon Title: **“FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS USELESS”**

James 2:18-20

- If someone \_\_\_\_\_ believes ‘I’m a Christian’ and can go on living life \_\_\_\_\_ by a relationship with Christ, is that person’s profession of faith \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_?
- There’s an attempt someone is making to \_\_\_\_\_ faith from works and James’ conclusion is it \_\_\_\_\_
- “Seek” = to investigate; \_\_\_\_\_; crave after (there’s an aspect of this work, which \_\_\_\_\_ the person to \_\_\_\_\_)
- “Show” = prove; \_\_\_\_\_; expose to the eyes; to give evidence
- Yes, God is \_\_\_\_\_ and if you believe that, you will love Him with ALL of your \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_!!!
- “You do well” on one hand, it is commendable that this person \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ correct Biblical truth, however, unless that faith goes farther, it will \_\_\_\_\_
- There are NO \_\_\_\_\_ demons; demons AREN’T atheists; demons know who God is – their ‘faith’ is \_\_\_\_\_
- There’s NO doubt that the demons \_\_\_\_\_ in Biblical truth, BUT, this head knowledge alone \_\_\_\_\_
- The implication from this text is that the demons’ ‘faith’ has MORE \_\_\_\_\_ than those who claim faith \_\_\_\_\_ works
- “Shudder” = to \_\_\_\_\_; to quake; to tremble (there’s a tangible fear that grips these demons because of \_\_\_\_\_)
- “\_\_\_\_\_” = to know; to gain knowledge; to perceive
- “Foolish” = vain; \_\_\_\_\_; devoid of truth (trying to separate faith from works leaves you an \_\_\_\_\_)
- “Useless” = \_\_\_\_\_; ineffective; shunning the work which one ought to perform (it connects 2 Greek words – “\_\_\_\_\_” and “\_\_\_\_\_”)
