- When a tiny \_\_\_\_\_ is uncontrolled it can cause \_\_\_\_\_ damage
- The tongue is incredibly \_\_\_\_\_\_ and we need to recognize how much we MUST depend on the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for help
- In many other languages, a \_\_\_\_\_ is often referred to as a \_\_\_\_\_ (because it resembles a tongue as it \_\_\_\_\_ and dances)

- This seems to \_\_\_\_\_\_ the devolving negative spread (it doesn't stay \_\_\_\_\_\_ ALL aspects of our lives get scorched)
- The tongue, which \_\_\_\_\_\_ the fire, is in the end, \_\_\_\_\_ by fire (if NOT controlled)
- "Tame" = to subdue; to bring \_\_\_\_\_\_

  - $\circ$  2 Little \_\_\_\_\_ on a large ship
  - o 3 Small \_\_\_\_\_, which sets the whole \_\_\_\_\_ ablaze
  - 4 \_\_\_\_\_ the tongue
