

Sermon Title: **“ONLY ONE LAWGIVER & JUDGE”**

James 4:11-12

- Unchecked and unfiltered \_\_\_\_\_ is devastatingly \_\_\_\_\_
- As we approach James 4:11-12, the \_\_\_\_\_ we share with other believers needs to be \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_
- There’s a drastic difference between \_\_\_\_\_ someone and sitting in a place where you \_\_\_\_\_ on someone
- Before we \_\_\_\_\_ another believer with a potential sin issue, we must \_\_\_\_\_ our own hearts
- “Do not speak \_\_\_\_\_” = literally means – to speak down or against (this is someone looking to \_\_\_\_\_ someone’s reputation)
- Speaking ill of a brother or sister in Christ \_\_\_\_\_ the precious bond which we both share through \_\_\_\_\_
- When James says, “Speaks against the \_\_\_\_\_ and judges the \_\_\_\_\_”, what he means is “they are applying the Law and it’s NOT \_\_\_\_\_”
- Before we share something about someone else – ask \_\_\_\_\_ questions:
  1. Have I already shared this \_\_\_\_\_ the person it’s about?
  2. How does my sharing this \_\_\_\_\_ that person or situation?
- None of us are perfect, we are all equally \_\_\_\_\_ to God for what we \_\_\_\_\_ in and how we daily live
- When we attempt to act as the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, we elevate ourselves & deny the authority, which we are all subject
- Pride has \_\_\_\_\_ and it’s prideful to sit on God’s judgment seat, we have \_\_\_\_\_ to execute judgment on anyone
- “Judge” = one who makes \_\_\_\_\_ based upon examination and evaluation
