Luke 17:11-19

- Have I actually \_\_\_\_\_ to thank God for answering my prayers and for \_\_\_\_\_ in my life?
- This area between \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ was a region where half-breeds lived (half Jew & half Gentile) – the \_\_\_\_\_ people wanted nothing to do with \_\_\_\_\_
