

Sermon Title: **“HALLELUJAH!”**

Revelation 19:1-10

- The Marriage Supper of the Lamb
 - 4 Times the word “Hallelujah” is used
- The curtain is rolled back & we get to glimpse at the worship of Almighty God’s victory over Babylon
 - Babylon is basically an evil world system that is controlled by the Antichrist during the last days
 - One day in the future, nothing is going to go unaddressed (every knee will bow & every tongue will confess that Jesus is Lord)
- Babylon’s judgment & destruction is final & it will never cause problems again
- Who are the 24 elders? (Revelation 4:1-4)
 - John Piper – “These 24 elders are maybe, representatives of the 12 Tribes of Israel & the 12 Apostles of the Lamb from the church.” (taken from Revelation 12:12-14)
- Who are the 4 Living Creatures?
 - These are 4 real, actual beings (angels)
- Here’s the point: each of these incredibly powerful & important beings, all of them, fall down before God & worship Him
 - As powerful & significant as they are, they recognize Who is worthy of ALL praise
- A proclamation to give praise is presented & in unity, together in one, mighty voice, this multitude cries out – HALLELUJAH!
- That anticipated promise (the future hope, we’ve longed for) is NOW no longer a distant idea, it’s a present reality!
