

Sermon Title: **“SACRIFICIAL SON”**

Genesis 22:1-14

- Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_, however, before He dawned the crown He deserves, He \_\_\_\_\_ Himself to die
- Our rebellion and sin required a \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice and the ONLY sufficient sacrifice had to be \_\_\_\_\_ and eternal (ONLY Jesus fit that criteria)
- To Abraham, all \_\_\_\_\_ were attached to Isaac (Isaac, was the son of \_\_\_\_\_, through whom the whole earth would be blessed)
- God goes \_\_\_\_\_ to the heart (what do you \_\_\_\_\_ MOST?)
- What God is saying goes deeper, go to Mt. Moriah (a \_\_\_\_\_ journey) offer your son to Me as an \_\_\_\_\_
- Commentaries vary on how old Isaac was at this time (consensus is between \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ years old)
  - At some point, the son willingly \_\_\_\_\_ (sound familiar – NO one \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus’ life, He laid it down)
  - Do we view our times of \_\_\_\_\_, those tough moments of sacrificing our will in obedience, as an \_\_\_\_\_?

- Reminder of some of the parallels between Isaac & Jesus:
  - 1 – BOTH ... were \_\_\_\_\_ of promise
  - 2 – BOTH ... were miraculously \_\_\_\_\_
  - 3 – BOTH ... were \_\_\_\_\_ by their fathers
  - 4 – BOTH ... rode in on \_\_\_\_\_
  - 5 – BOTH ... had \_\_\_\_\_ with them
  - 6 – BOTH ... carried wood up a hill for their \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice
  - 7 – BOTH ... asked their \_\_\_\_\_ questions
  - 8 – BOTH ... were \_\_\_\_\_ for 3 days
