


# PASSING THE TORCH A Study in First Timothy

### CONTENTMENT

I Timothy 6:3-4a Those advocating a different doctrine DON'T advertise themselves (They're Wolves in sheep's clothing)

There are some people who are so good at talking that they can convince others that they're experts when they're NOT I Timothy 6:4b-5

Sophists were people pleasers:


2. They waxed eloquent on ridiculous stuff

"Constant friction between men" = (Greek) paints a picture of rubbing up against one another like an infected sheep does (Spreading infection to others) I Timothy 6:6-8

"Contentment" = a complete self-sufficiency; independent of ALL Outward things Philippians 4:11-13
