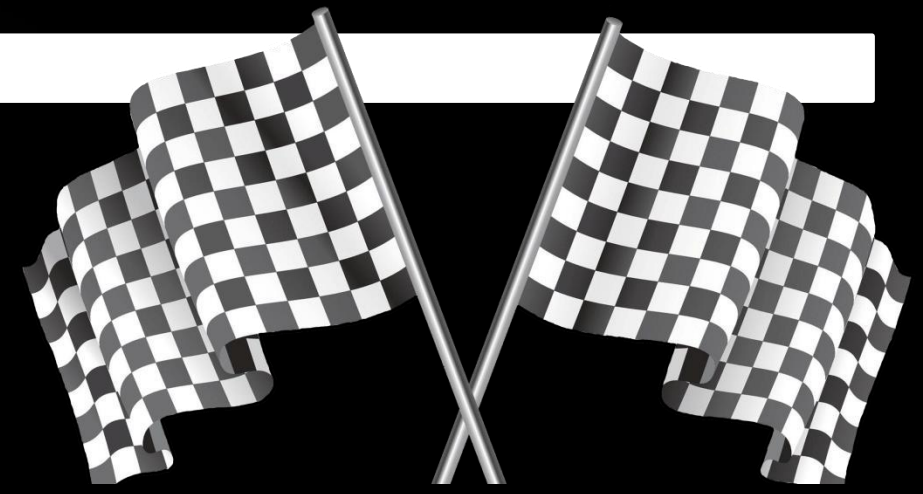

We DON'T have to be

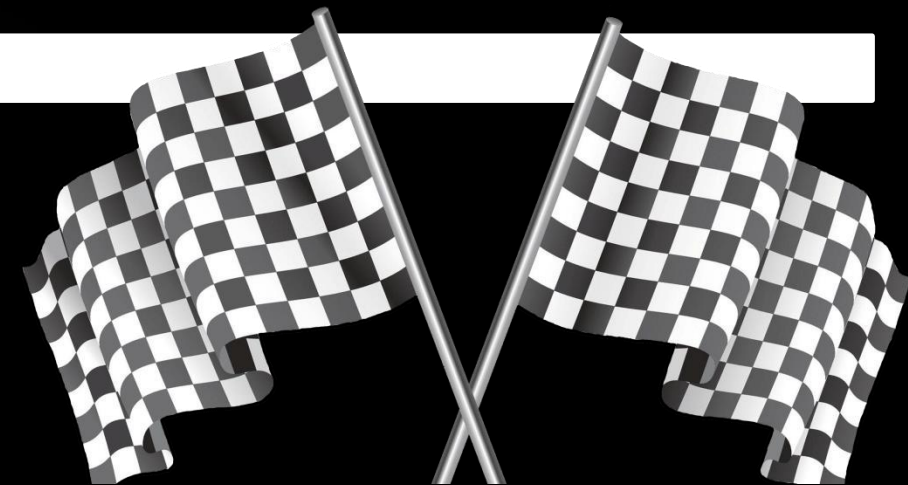
Afraid or **Ashamed**

**I AM NOT
ASHAMED**





II Timothy 1:8

With everything that had happened recently: Paul in **prison** & great widespread **persecution** throughout ALL of the Roman Empire





Some had **abandoned** ship
– they had **walked away**
from the faith

“Ashamed” = to feel shame or
embarrassment for something





With Paul being put in **prison**
some people had used that
as a reason to **deny** their
relationship with Christ





When you go through a period
of **persecution** or a time of trouble
the **closeness** that you **experience**
with God is unparalleled

II Timothy 1:9-11





When we think about Who
Jesus is & what He's done we
should **marvel** & stand in **awe**
(drawing us to utter worship)





ALL of the Bible
(Old Testament included)
points to God's **love**
What Jesus did on the **CROSS**
we could NEVER have done





This message of
Hope is **entrusted** to
EACH of us to **spread**





Make it personal – if our
comfort was rocked how
committed to Jesus would
we still be? (Are we really
ALL-in for Jesus?)

Dwelling on Who God is helps to
keep our minds **grounded** in the
reality of what God's truly **capable**
of doing on our behalf





When Paul accepted Christ as his personal Savior, Paul committed his entire life into Jesus' hands (Paul **dedicated** himself to God)
