







Ephesus was the capital of the western part of Asia

















I Timothy 1:3-4 "Urged" = (it's actually a military term) to draw Timothy's attention to the seriousness of the problem at hand

They're tasked with the **Orders** to pass these things along to the **Other soldiers** in the church

People in Ephesus were Wrongly using the O.T. Law (& genealogies) & the resulting new teaching led others astray from the grace found in a relationship with Jesus

The goal of the instruction should be: I Timothy 1:5 The instruction Timothy should be giving should result in love



2. A Good Conscience

3. A Sincere Faith

James 2:18 Inward change from a relationship with Christ results in overflowing outward changes as well

I Timothy 1:6-7 There were some men who were "straying from these things" = (literally) "having missed the mark — they swerved the wrong way"

Some men who desired to be teachers (the position — they wanted to be called "Rabbi") they DIDN'T understand the implications of their own teachings
