

## Judges 1:11-2:5



Judges 1:11-15 "Kiriath-sepher" = the city of Books (the location where learning took place) Judges 1:16-20 Exodus 18:27

"The city of palms" = refers to the area where the city of Jericho previously existed before Joshua led Israel to conquer it

## Judah could NOT drive ov the inhabitance of the valley because they had iron chariots Job 42:1-6

Quote (see note sheet) Deuteronomy 1:34-36 Once in Hebron, Caleb had to drive out (& he did) the 3 sons of Anak, who were large men & fierce warriors

Caleb was an old man, yet in God's strength he defeated these 3 mighty giants. Compare that to the lack of trust Judah displayed

Judges 1:21 Judges 1:22-26 "The house of Joseph" = refers to the combined tribes of Manasseh & Ephraim (cf. Joshua 17:17)

The location of Bethel is interesting. It apparently sat on the border of the territory given to Ephraim & the territory given to Benjamin

We again DON'T see them driving out ALL of the inhabitants, a nameless man is allowed to stay (& he built the city of Luz) Judges 1:27-28

## 9 of the 12 tribes are mentioned (minus - Gad, Issachar, & Reuben)

Each tribe is connected to Failure to completely drive out the Canaanites (which was God's clear command)
