

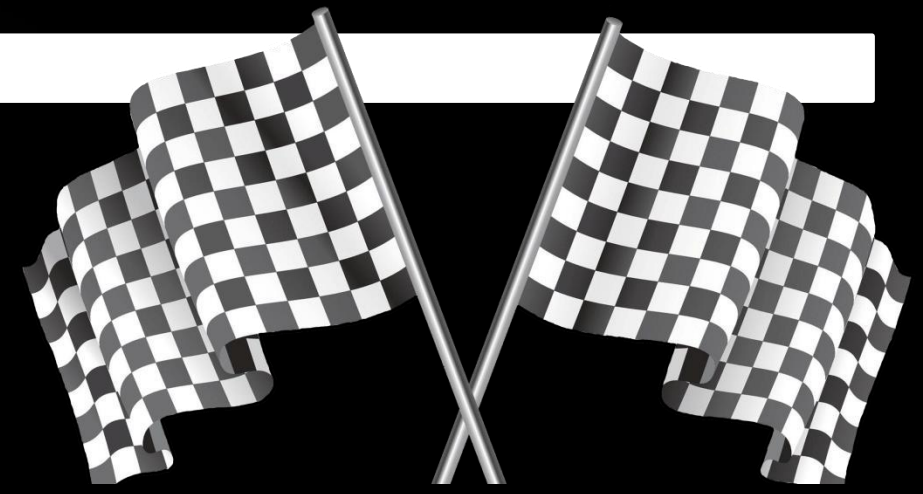

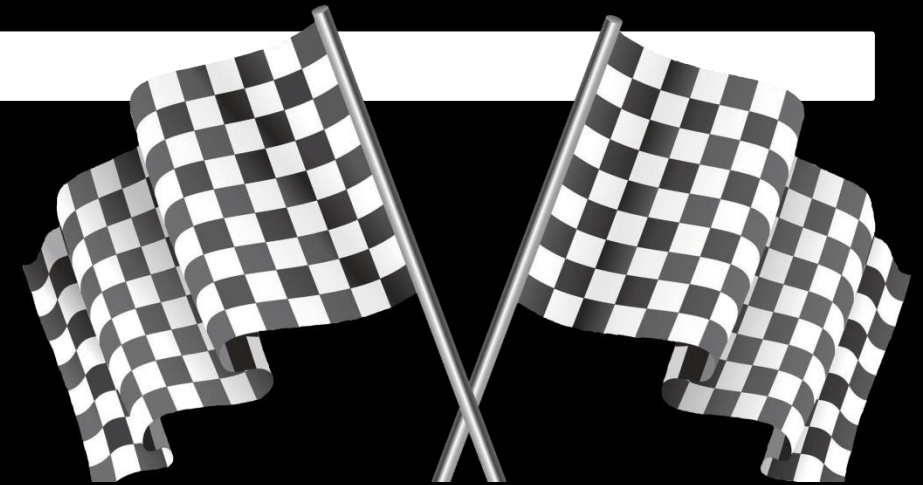

II Timothy 3:12

II Timothy 3:13

“Evil men” = those are the  
ones who **blatantly reject**  
& **deny** God







“Imposters” = are the ones who  
are the **wolves** in **sheep's clothing**

They'll NOT only **deceive**  
others, but they themselves  
will be **deceived**





II Timothy 3:14-15

Timothy's mom was **Jewish**

& Timothy was raised to

know the **Law** (like a good

Jewish boy)





At some point it stopped  
being just **head knowledge**

– Timothy accepted Jesus

Christ as his **personal**

**Savior** (through faith)





II Timothy 3:16-17

What separates the Bible  
from ALL other writings is

It's **Authority, Accuracy, &  
Ability**
