

PASSING THE TORCH A Study in First Timothy

1 Timothy 6:1-2 The population of slaves were large enough to be viewed as a potential threat



REGARD YOUR OWN MASTERS AS WORTHY

I Timothy 6:1-2 "Under the Yoke of slaves" = (metaphor) being under the lule of a master; either as apprentice or by being bought or hired

We're under someone's authority & labor is upon our shoulders "Honor" = to show someone else reverence which belongs to them

It has ZERO to do with whether you "Carn it" or NOT

The way we show respect to those over us is a direct reflection on how we honor God

What you do is for God it's a way of saying "I Love You" (& I will show it through my words & actions to my Boss)

I Timothy 6:2 I think internally because we share the common bond of a relationship with Christ at some level we expectdifferent treatment

However, equality in Christ ... DOESN'T eliminate God's order of authority here on earth

NONE of the authorities in our lives Vanish because of a personal relationship with Christ (they're actually only further highlighted) 5
