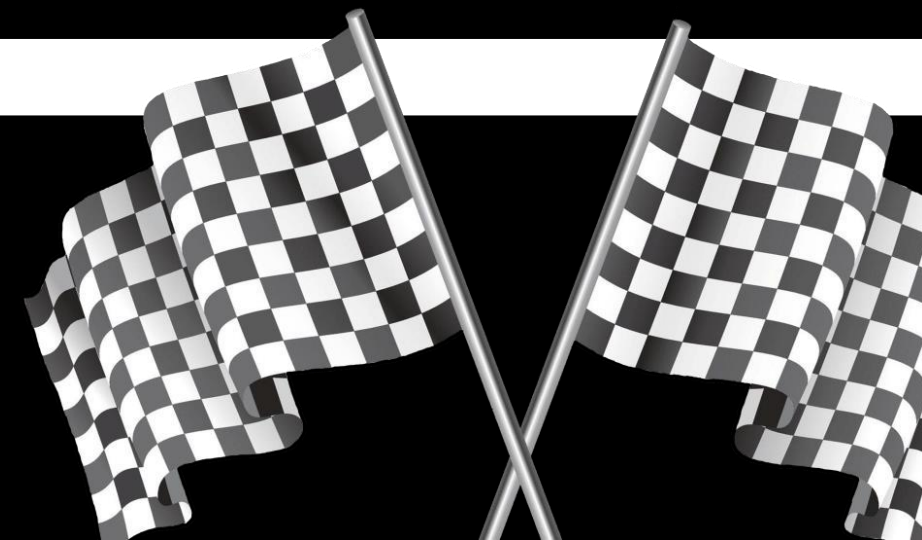

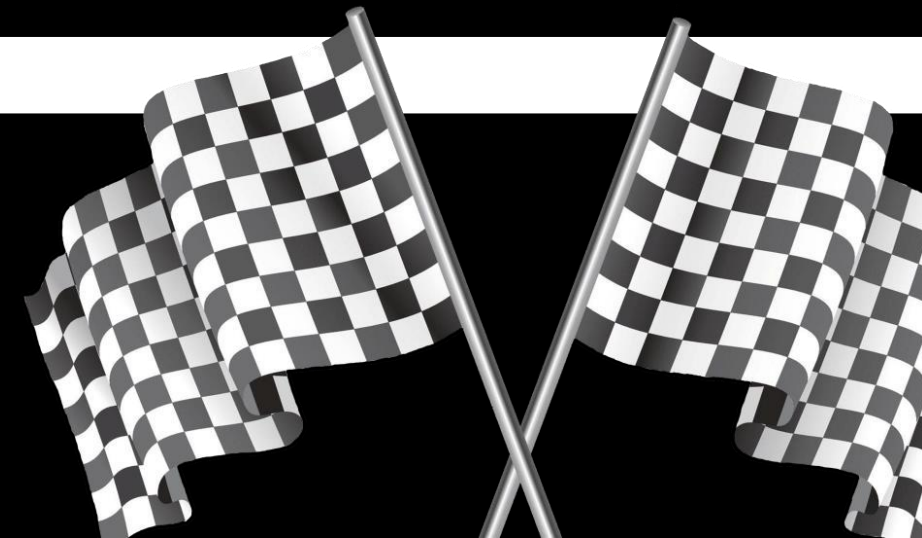

Jesus in the midst of hardship

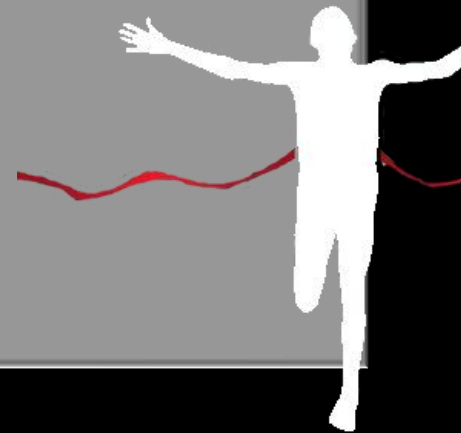

that Paul makes:

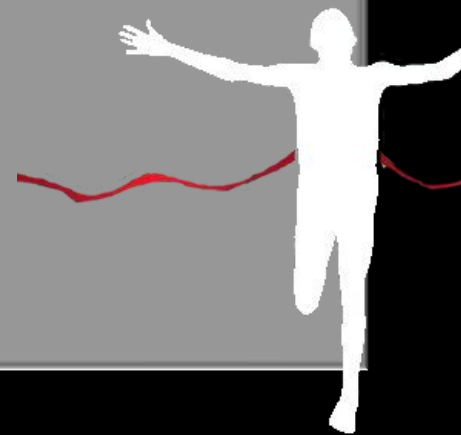
1. If we **died** with Him ...







The ultimate pre-requisite

II. If we **endure** ...


James 1:2-4
