I Timothy 1:8

“The **Law**” = the compilation
of decrees found in the
1st **5** books of the Bible



With or without the Law **sin**

us **guilty** ... declares us vile,
wicked, rotten, & **sinners!**

Grace, . NOT Law

Law, He's the **Answer** to our
problem that the
Law draws our
attention to

for Timothy, who's main
ministry was to people
of **Jewish** background
